

Frayed Knot Theatre Company was established in 1991 and has gone from strength to strength ever since. Initially, lacking resources and a known name we had to be modest in our productions, performing to a few dozen people in village halls in Herts, Beds & Bucks.

With the reopening of Pendley Theatre (as the Court Theatre) we decided to take the quite bold move to this larger venue, and happily it paid off. We have been able to increase from one show a year to two and, for the last couple of years, three.

The general trend, with only slight setbacks, has been an increase in audience numbers with every show, and our membership has grown too, particularly attracting members from the Aylesbury area.

We have until now, almost exclusively produced comedies, and have perhaps found a little niche in the busy Arts schedule in the area by doing so. Our last show however was not a comedy, but a ghost story. Now in our eighth year, we have become established as one the foremost companies in the area, with a dynamic approach and flexible attitude and are set to continue for many more years, hopefully gaining in experience and popularity all the time. We are always on the look-out for new recruits in every aspect of production - Acting, Directing, Back-stage, Technical and Management. So, if you'd like to have a bash yourself, why not get in touch with one of the members and join our society.

Recently our three shows have effectively been such that the Spring show is a well known play, our Autumn show of a new or more adventurous kind and the show near Christmas being something quite jolly! This cocktail seems to have worked well, and may well continue. Our first play this year, Arsenic and Old Hace of course, fell into the first of the above categories - and was highly successful. I hope that this re-run of Marreau and the Chacolate Holiceman lives up to our growing reputation and up to the original performance of 1991. I trust that you will have a thoroughly enjoyable evening ... and can't wait to come to see our next production whatever it is!!!

Marreau and the Chocolate Policeman

Director's Note

When I first wrote "Dashed strange don't you think" as the opening line of a sketch I was writing back in 1990, I little thought that I was in fact writing the first words of a sequence of six plays. And creating some (modestly and locally) popular characters in Marreau, Simpson, Gwendolyn, Protheroe and Farmer. Originally it was only meant to be a ten-minute sketch spoofing detectives such as Poirot, Holmes and Lord Peter Wimsey. But it grew ... and it grew until I had a play on my hands. Not a very long play, but a play nonetheless. At the time a group of us had been putting on "flying" shows around village halls with Phoenix Theatre Company. So with Phoenix' help we put on Marreau and the Chocolate Policeman. That first night we played to an audience of thirteen at Marsworth Village Hall on 24th April 1991. I wonder if any of you watching tonight were one of those thirteen! We did four performances in four different village halls and then in the June we did it once more in the Crystal Rooms for Festival Fringe. The audiences seemed to appreciate it - and the cast enjoyed performing it ... and so a sequel seemed a good idea. With the sequel was born Fraged Innt and the rest is history ... well our theatre company's history at any rate!

It has been a pleasure - and a slightly strange experience - to direct this play once again. Despite the seven year interval everyone who was in the original found the words remarkably familiar at the read-through for this re-run, thus giving the feeling that 1991 was very recent ... but for several of us the intervening years have actually seen considerable changes. Frayed Knot has grown remarkably in this period too, and is now one of Tring's leading dramatic societies, with about twenty plays "under our belts" and hopefully dozens more to follow in the coming years.

I would particularly like to thank Lynn and Jayne for their unstinting help and hard work with this show - having a producer (let alone two!) is a wonderful boon. Rob Farrow
